MATTERS ARISING FROM APRIL'S MEETING

SILIAN

The common - in Silian has a serious problem with dog fouling. Cllr Holgate advised that Llangybi had a similar issue a few years ago and had the environment agency out, they had a leaflet drop and will look for the originals for us to see. It did not make a difference in the village as the dogs in Llangybi were mainly unattended. Cllr Evans and Cllr Coviello said that this was not the case in Silian. If a bin is purchased, who will empty it? Cllr Evans recalls that somebody was willing, Cllr Coviello and Cllr Evans will sort this out. It was requested by Cllr Evans that the Community Council was willing to fund the purchase of the bin, Cllr Holgate proposed this and seconded by Cllr Cairns. Cllr Coviello will purchase it and clerk to reimburse and Cllr E Evans will organise the fixing of it to a lamp post.

Planning at Gelligwenyn – Cllr Coviello declared an interest as it is his neighbour, a planning application has gone in for a mobile home, a query was sent in by the clerk to see if this was for the mobile that was already there or for a new one, no response as yet! Clerk to send a prompt to the council and copy in Cllr O Davies.

Clerk to send an email to Cllr O Davies to report that locals have shown concerns regarding the field in Coxhead where the entrance has moved, has planning permission been given? and there is a mess in the field where a business seems to be running, is there a licence?
